Admission Policy

Any person 16 years of age or older with a high school diploma or General Education Development (GED) Diploma is eligible for admission.

- 1 Complete the Western Dakota Tech application for admissions online at www.wdt.edu.
- 2 Complete the ACCUPLACER test. (\$15 fee) (The ACCUPLACER test will be waived if you have an ACT sub score of 18 or better in English, Math and Reading, or an SAT sub-score of at least 440 in Verbal and Math. The scores must within the last five years.) The ACCUPLACER test is offered Monday-Friday at 800 a.m. or 12:00 p.m.
- 3 Schedule your Admissions Advising Session.
- 4 Submit High School transcript or GED scores. (Also submit official college transcripts if you have previously attended a post-secondary institution.)
- 5 Submit Immunization Records verifying two doses of MMR vaccinations.
- 6 Once you receive your acceptance letter, schedule a time to register for classes.
